More information about Bharat Ratna:,

- The award of Bharat Ratna was started on January 2, 1954 by the then President Dr. Rajendra Prasad.
- Under the process of selection for Bharat Ratna award, the Prime Minister of India recommends the name of a person for Bharat Ratna to the President.
- No formal recommendation is required for Bharat Ratna. Any person can be considered eligible for this award without distinction on the basis of caste,

profession, position or gender.

- Bharat Ratna is the country's highest civilian honor which is given in recognition of exceptional and supreme service in any field. Hence statement 1 is wrong.
- According to the guidelines regarding Bharat Ratna, only three Bharat Ratnas are given in a year. Also, it is not necessary that Bharat Ratna award be given every year. However, the tradition of giving this award to a maximum of three people has been broken twice.
- This rule was broken for the first time in the year 1999 where four persons were awarded Bharat Ratna which included Jayaprakash Narayan, Amartya Sen, Gopinath Bordoloi and Ravi Shankar. Then in the year 2024, once again breaking the rules, five people have been honored with this award. Hence statement 2 is wrong.
- According to Article 18(1) of the Constitution, this award cannot be mentioned before or after the name of the recipient. Because according to the Supreme Court, Bharat Ratna and Padma awards are not titles under Article 18(1) of the Constitution of India. Hence statement 2 is wrong.

- World Tuberculosis Day is celebrated every year on 24 March to eradicate bacterial TB (tuberculosis). Hence statement 1 is correct.
- The theme of World Tuberculosis Day 2024 is "Yes! "We can end TB" (Yes! we can end TB). Hence statement 2 is not correct.
- To raise awareness about TB and its global impact, "International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Disease (IUATLD)" had proposed to celebrate 24 March as World TB Day. After this, the first World TB Day was officially celebrated in 1983.

- 1. India has conducted the first flight test of indigenously manufactured Agni-4 missile under 'Mission Divyastra'.
